

Privacy policy - information clause on the processing of personal data for customers

Based on Article. 13 (1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016. on the protection of personal data and their processing ("GDPR"), we would like to inform you that if you fill in the form on the website www.beautyinvest.pl, we are the Administrator of your personal data.

1. Administrator's contact details.

2. Purposes of processing.

Please be advised that the Administrator will process your personal data for the purposes of:

- conclusion and performance of the contract, provision of services resulting therefrom and handling of any complaints
- data processing for tax and accounting purposes,
- in order for the Administrator to fulfill other legal obligations.

3. No obligation to provide data.

The administrator, in order to conclude and perform the contract, may require you to provide the following personal data: name and surname, company and business address, numbers in the relevant registers (NIP), contact details (e-mail address, telephone number), telephone number bank account.

Providing the above data is not obligatory, but it is necessary to conclude a contract; in their absence, the performance of the contract may be impossible.

4. Recipients.

In order to implement the above-mentioned purposes, the Administrator may transfer your data to the following categories of recipients: Administrator's employees and associates. Your data may also be accessed by the Administrator's subcontractors, in particular accounting and IT companies. Your personal data will not be transferred to external entities for marketing purposes.

5. Processing time.

Your personal data will be kept for the duration of the contract and after its termination for the period of:

- 1 year to consider any complaints or willingness to make a similar order,
- 5 years, in order to fulfill obligations resulting from legal provisions (the Accounting Act),
- for marketing purposes, until the consent is withdrawn.

6. Rights/ Permission.

You have the right to access your personal data, to rectify personal data, delete data and the right to limit their processing. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the law.

7. Security.

We attach great importance to ensuring the security of information received from you. In order to prevent third parties from accessing or disclosing information, we use physical, electronic and organizational procedures to protect the information we collect.
